...Goals

Some of the ministry goals we're working on in the coming years:

- Focus on facilitating ministry by connecting people with resources for outreach and ministry;
- Continue training leaders at all levels;
- Promote LLM's mission and ministry in the congregations; help them see what they can be doing right now, even without a professional church worker
- Encourage leaders to start small groups in their homes to build relationships and make disciples
 We'll be forming a Strategic Ministry Planning Team to discern prayerfully God's clear direction to set mid-term and long-term goals, and make action plans to accomplish those goals.

Lutheran Heritage Foundation booklet "Jesus Never Fails" was translated into Maya and published in a Spanish/Maya bilingual format. The first draft of the translation of *Martin Luther's Small Catechism* into Maya was completed in January. Translations are being done by **Pr. Ruberto Ek Yah** with help from **Professor Felipe de Jesús Castillo Tzec**, who teaches the Maya language through the organization INDEMAYA in Yucatan, Mexico. These projects are encouraged and promoted by LLM but are funded independently. LLM is partnering with Living Way Bible Study (LWBS), a non-profit LCMS organization that provides high quality Bible studies free of charge. Two LWBS studies, "Important People of the Old Testament" and "Mark", were translated into Spanish a number of years ago but only exist in a few poor-quality photocopies. LLM President Pam Bridgehouse is re-typing those Spanish-language studies to facilitate updating the language and appearance of the materials before making them widely available. Deaconess Luz Guerrero Kramer is translating the study on The Parables of Jesus into Spanish. The project is being jointly coordinated by LWBS Board Member, Rev. Mike Kasting and LLM President Pam Bridgehouse.

God has opened door after door for LLM since the late 1980s! We are grateful to God and all you who pray and give to make it happen!
